Qualifications shall include:

1. Minimum ten (10) years in responsible charge of projects within the construction industry.
2. Registration as a Building Inspector and Plans Examiner and shall submit application for registration as a provisional Building Official with the State of Michigan in accordance with the provisions of PA 54, 1986.
3. Must obtain ICC Certification as a Building Inspector and Plans Examiner within six (6) months of hire and must obtain Certified Building Official Certification within one (10 year of hire.
