Duties: Reviews proposed construction plans and documents to determine compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and Michigan Electrical Code. Issues written notices of Michigan Electrical Code violations requiring corrective action. Explains, both verbally and in writing, the electrical codes to architects, engineers, owners, contractors, electricians, governmental officials, and the public. Gathers evidence on reported code violations and prepares necessary reports.

Requirements: Six years of experience in the electrical trade, including two years equivalent to a journey-level electrician. Possession of a journey or master electrician's license issued by the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or a municipality with a State of Michigan approved licensing program. Individuals must meet the requirements of the Skilled Trades Regulation Act, 2016 PA 407 and become registered as an electrical inspector and plan reviewer.
